

2008 JR ACME SECTIONAL/DISTRICT TOURNAMENT

- 1) This is a double elimination format for both the sectional and district bracket with the district winner advancing on to the State Tournament to be held at Lima Shawnee High School beginning on Saturday, July 12.
- 2) Each team is responsible for sharing the umpire cost for each game. (PLEASE BRING \$45 CASH OR CHECK TO BE PAID AT THE PRE-GAME MEETING).
- 3) Each team is to furnish two (2) game balls to the umpire at the pre-game meeting, and more if necessary during the game.
- 4) Each team may take a maximum of 15 minutes of infield practice prior to the start of their first game of the day: home team 35 minutes prior to game time and the visiting team 20 minutes prior to game time. THERE WILL BE NO INFIELD PRACTICE AFTER YOU HAVE PLAYED YOUR FIRST GAME OF THAT DAY.
- 5) The pre-game meeting of head coaches and umpires shall take place 5 minutes prior to game time. Coaches shall give the home plate umpire their line-up card and all changes shall be reported through him during the game. You may need to advise the umpires of this procedure since we typically do not do this during summer games.
- 6) We will follow the OHSAA Baseball Rules including the 10 run rule after 4½ or 5 innings, no courtesy runners or EH, and the pitching rule of a maximum of 10 innings in a 3 day period (1 pitch constitutes an inning).
- 7) The top team or first team listed shall be the home team in the sectional bracket. A coin flip for the best of 3 district series shall determine the home team of the first game, with the other team being the home team the second game. If the third game is necessary, a coin flip again shall determine the home team. Please get together for a coin toss as soon as possible or the first team there and ready should take infield 35 minutes prior to game time.
- 8) Umpires have been assigned by the host site.
- 9) There may be an admission fee of \$2 for adults and \$1 for students with those under 6 free for all tournament games where possible to charge to help defray field management expenses. This shall be a daily fee if there are multiple games at said field.
- 10) Concession stands may be provided by the host site and teams are urged to support these and remain at the playing site when possible when multiple games are involved.
- 11) The winning coach shall report the game results to Lee Day (513) 850-1752 asap.
- 12) Sportsmanship should be stressed to all fans and is expected from all coaches and players.
- 13) In case of rain, you will be contacted by the host site or Lee Day with the following day used as make up date.
